Medical Devices ASEAN 2019 (“MDA 2019”) brings medical technology and devices from over 300 exhibiting brands and companies, coming from 10 countries - China, Germany, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, Singapore, Switzerland Taiwan and Thailand, together, from 10 to 12 July 2019, at Hall 5-6 IMPACT Exhibition & Convention Center, Bangkok, Thailand. Running alongside the three-day trade exhibition, is a range of activities, including a series of academic conferences and seminars.
