

The amazing Thai-Indian Fun Fair is back in town on Feb 16 at SWU.



The 5th Thai-Indian Fun-Fair event is returning to Srinakharinwirot University, Sukhumvit 23 in Bangkok on Saturday, 16th February 2019 from 1500-2200 hours. The annual popular event will be jointly organized by the Embassy of India, Srinakharinwirot University, and the Indian Social Club of Thailand that consist of 65 Associations of Indian Diaspora in Thailand.

The purpose of this event is to strengthen friendship and promote socio-economic and cultural relations between India and Thailand. It is expected that about 10,000 people including Students of Srinakharinwirot University will participate in the event.

Srinakharinwirot University hosted the first inaugural Thai-Indian Fun Fair in 2014 followed by Thammasat University (Tha Prachan Campus) in 2015 and Chulalongkorn University in 2016. Once again the popular event is returning to Srinakharinwirot University, Sukhumvit 23 in Bangkok. In 2018, SWU hosted the 4th Thai-Indian Fun Fair second time. This is the third time Srinakharinwirot University host annual fun fair at its prestigious campus.
